Auditor Murphy has recently been made aware of voters' concerns regarding COVID-19(Coronavirus). Bethany Murphy, Taylor County Auditor, and staff are committed to making sure that every eligible voter in Taylor County has the opportunity to vote and that their vote counts.

As the June 2, 2020 Primary Election is fast approaching, Auditor Murphy is encouraging those voters who have a concern with going to the polls to vote an absentee ballot by mail.

Primary Election ballots can be mailed 40 days (April 23, 2020) prior to the election. You can vote in the convenience of your own home and then return the voted ballot in the postage paid envelope to the Taylor County Auditor's Office. Additional absentee ballot request forms are available on the Taylor County website at www.taylorcountyiowa.org, the Office of the Secretary of State website <https://sos.iowa.gov>, or feel free to contact the Taylor County Auditor's Office and an absentee ballot request form can be mailed to you.
