Horton made a motion seconded by Fitzgerald to approve the offer to purchase the Purple Palace Building for \$70,000.00. Motion carried 3-0. There has been no official paperwork signed yet.

The Board continued work on the FY23 budget.

Horton made a motion seconded by Fitzgerald to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
