Cole Walter distributed a legislative update on how local budgets will be cut in the next years due to the end of the BPTC backfill.

Welch stated the company wanting to build the turbines is Apex. The proposed project would contain 50-54 turbines.

Robert Robinson spoke in support of the turbines. He stated the trucks are louder in the highway than the turbine. He also said they cut his tile when the project came through and they fixed it.

The Board all spoke in support of the project.
