The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Ron Fitzgerald, Pam Wilmarth, and Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

Fitzgerald made a motion seconded by Wilmarth to approve the minutes of last meeting and todays agenda. Motion carried 3-0.

JD King joined the meeting to update the Board on road projects, crews are hauling sand and others are cutting brush.

Fitzgerald made a motion seconded by Wilmarth to approve Resolution 2021-12 approving the construction evaluation. Motion carried 3-0.

Sue Cox joined the meeting to discuss health insurance numbers for FY22. A single policy increased by \$70.00 and the family policy increased by \$159.00. After much discussion the Board will continue to fully fund a single health insurance policy and increase the portion paid by employee for family insurance by \$40.00.

Wilmarth made a motion seconded by Fitzgerald to increase the insurance buy out from \$190.00 to \$225.00 starting in FY 2022. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved the claims to be paid.

No further business came before the Board at this time, and the meeting was adjourned subject to call.
